- Escalation point only when normal processes fail.

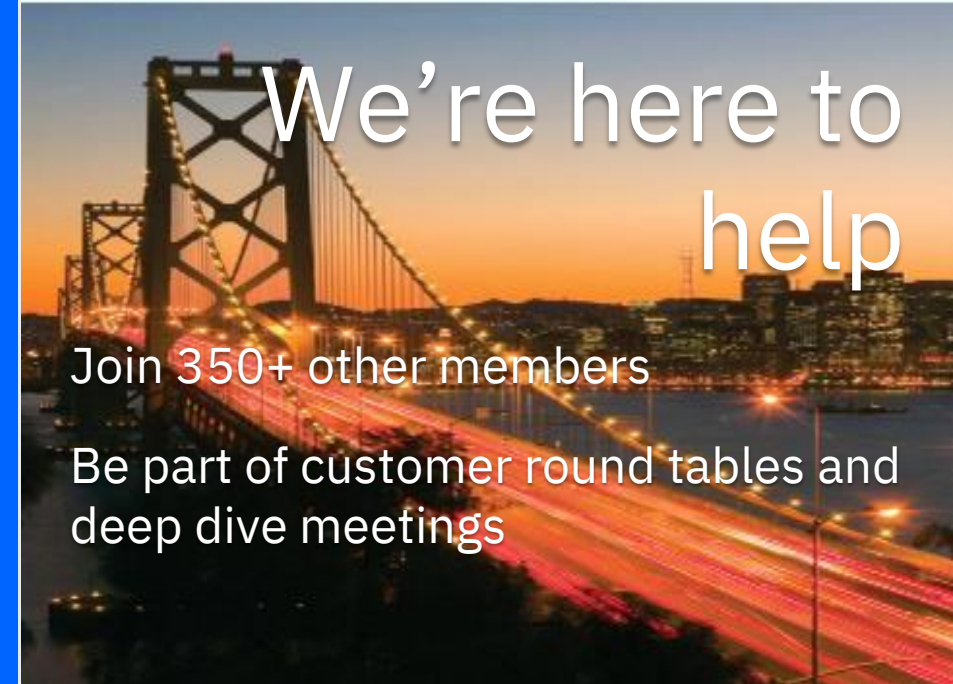
