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Formed in 2000, TfL is the integrated transport authority responsible for meeting the Mayor's strategy and commitments on transport in London.
We run the day-to-day operation of the Capital's public transport network and manage some of London's busiest roads



We manage a bus fleet of around 9,300 vehicles operating across 675 routes.

London Underground has 11 lines covering 402km and serving 270 stations. Handles up to five million passenger journeys a day and at peak times, there are more than 540 trains in service




The DLR has 45 stations and 149 vehicles

The London Overground network covers 112 stations across six routes

There are 14,790 kilometres of road in London. The Transport for London Road Network (or "red route" network) accounts for 590 kilometres (around 5% of the total road network in London, but carrying about 30% of the city's traffic!)


