UPDATE ... SET ROW

Description

The UPDATE statement can have a ROW keyword allowing the whole table to be updated from a record variable.
This is currently not supported in DB2.

Example:

```
procedure x
  oldrec TABLE%ROWTYPE;
begin
  UPDATE mytab
    SET ROW = oldrec
  WHERE rowid = objid;
end;
```

Solution

Remove the ROW keyword and expand all the columns on the left side, using the record.<column> syntax on the right side.

Example:

```
procedure x
  oldrec TABLE%ROWTYPE;
begin
  UPDATE mytab
    SET col1 = oldrec.col1,
      col2 = oldrec.col2,
      ....
      coln = oldrec.coln
  WHERE rowid = objid;
end;
```

Can be converted automatically: NO
