

# Assessing your options

- Timeline, timeline, timeline. End of service for v5.2.5 and below is Sep 30<sup>th</sup> 2019.
- IBM's intent is to announce 5.2.6 end of service in 2H 2019. Customers will be given at least 12 -18 months to prepare
- Consider your deployment-specific usage. This will guide you towards in place or fresh new install.
- Define scope: Take advantage of hardware and technology stack upgrades, private/public cloud and new features and functions
- Build your roadmap. Sequential steps to get you to your destination

# Traditional path

- IBM Installation Manager (IIM) – introduced with 5.2.6
- v6.0 supports Linux, Unix and Windows. Support for Solaris, HP-UX and iSeries deprecated in v6.0
- In place upgrade:
  - Keep your existing file system – much like a patch
  - For stack updates such as moving from RedHat 6 to RedHat 7. Install B2Bi fresh on a newly provisioned application server, and choose option in IIM to upgrade the database, thus persevering your transactional and non-transactional data
  - Fresh Install with Migration
    - Install as new, export resources from legacy, import and adjust in 6.0.2. Advantage here is the database is clean (no orphaned data migrated to v6.0)



# B2Bi Docker Image

- B2Bi Docker image consists of the following layered file system:
  - Ubuntu as base image (this will shift to Red Hat in the near future)
  - IBM JRE
  - IBM WebSphere Liberty
  - B2Bi jars, noapp, etc.,
- B2Bi Docker Container – runtime instance of an image plus a read/write layer
  - Each B2Bi Docker Container runs all the B2Bi processes i.e ASI, Adapter Container , API etc.,
  - Optionally you can run Adapter Container , APIs into separate Docker Containers



# Going to Docker

- **Docker-based management**
  - v6.0 features a Linux x86\_64-based container image
  - Database remains as-is and must be external to the container
  - Cluster deployments still require a shared DB and shared file system
- **Upgrade:**
  - Download v6.0 image from Passport Advantage. Application including the operating system, system libraries and all dependencies (Java, Liberty, etc) are preconfigured. Configure setup.cfg to denote an upgrade. This will upgrade the 5.2 schema to v6.0. Since both transaction and non-transactional data (TP setup, maps, envelopes, bps etc) are stored in the DB. Choosing this option will eliminate the need for export and import.
- **Fresh Install:**
  - Install as new, export resources from legacy, Import and adjust in 6.0.2. Advantage here is the database is clean (no orphaned data migrated to v6.0)

# Global Mailbox and Restful APIs




- Global Mailbox v6.0.2
  - Modern enterprises require an always-on 24x7 system
  - Downtime is costly and simply isn't an option
  - Global Mailbox ensures maximum system and file availability even in the event of a DC-wide disaster
  - Global Mailbox supports rolling upgrades, providing zero-downtime maintenance
  - Supports 2 or more geographically data centers
  - Options such as public cloud hosting fully supported. A hybrid multi-cloud setup is a good option for a flexible highly resilient architecture
  - All major protocols supported (AS2, myFG, Connect:Direct, FTP(s), SFTP)


